1. Read the CSHS constitution and school By-Laws Template.
2. Print and fill out a CHSH chapter application.
3. Have school principal sign the application.
4. Send your completed application to cshs@codevirginia.org

1. Finalize your By-Laws and upload to Google Drive.
2. Complete Chapter Demographics Form online (link will be emailed to you).
3. Use the drive to share photos, and any documents you create for the your chapter of the CSHS.
